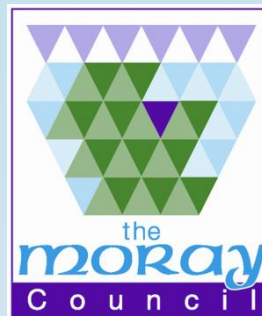

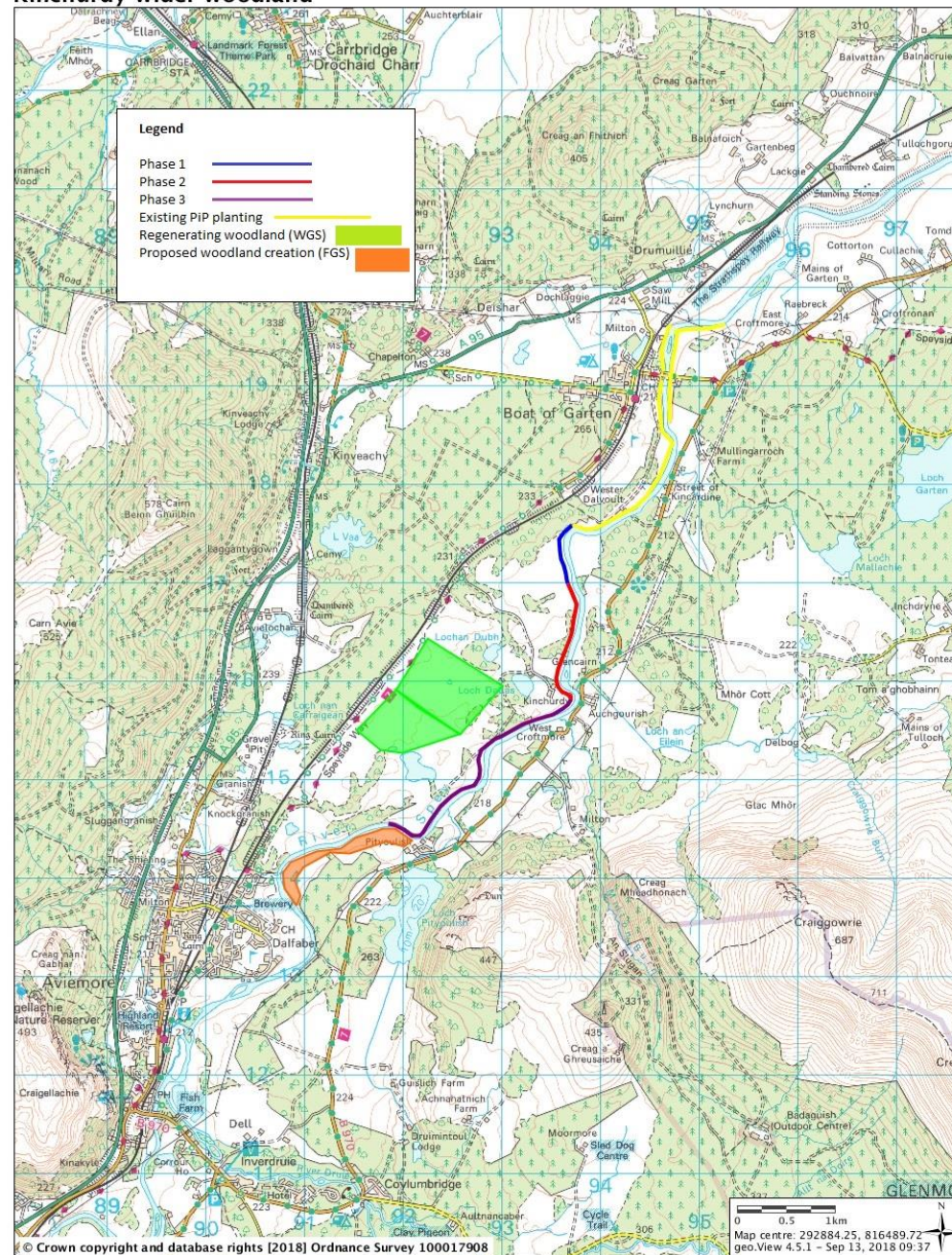

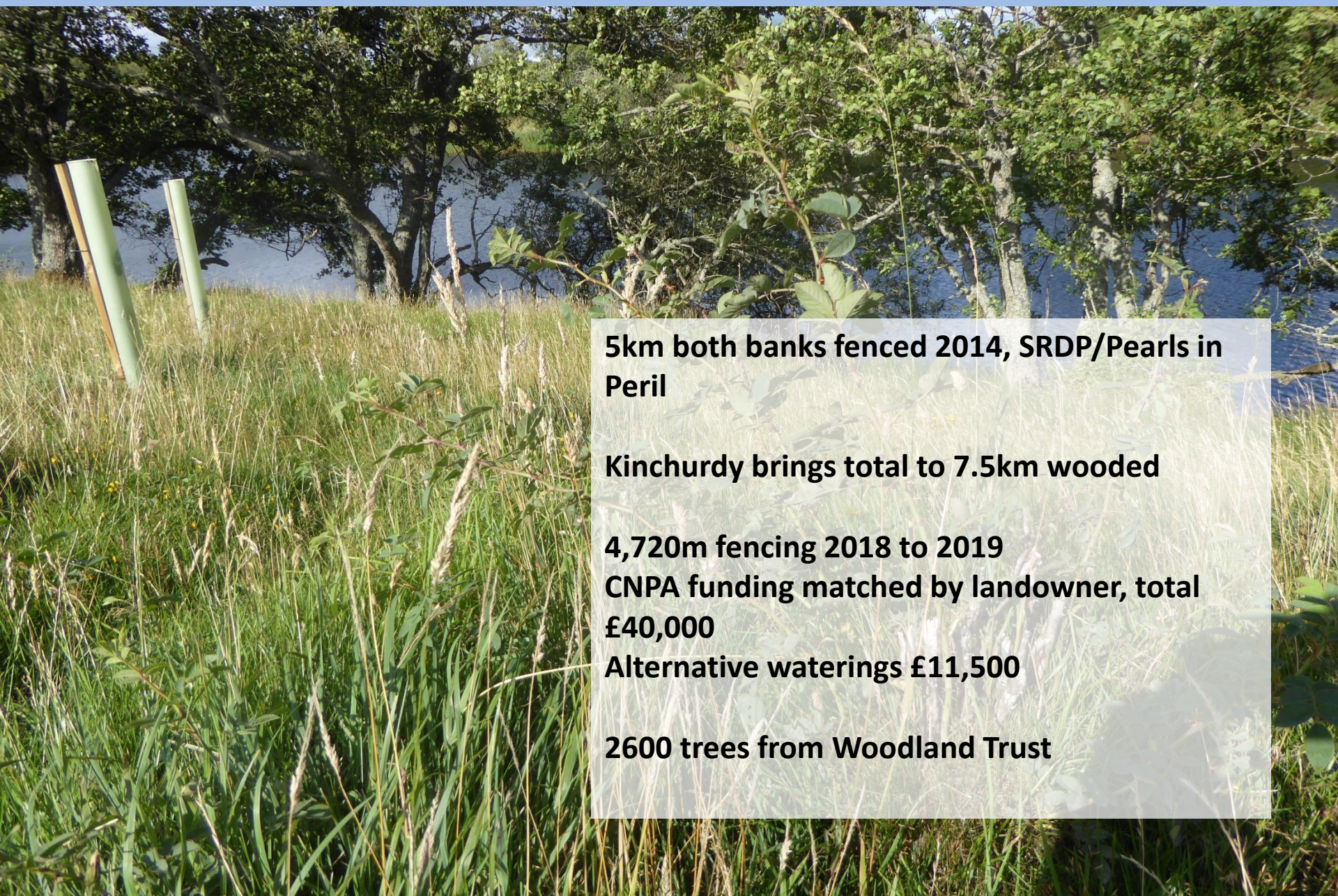

2600 trees from Woodland Trust



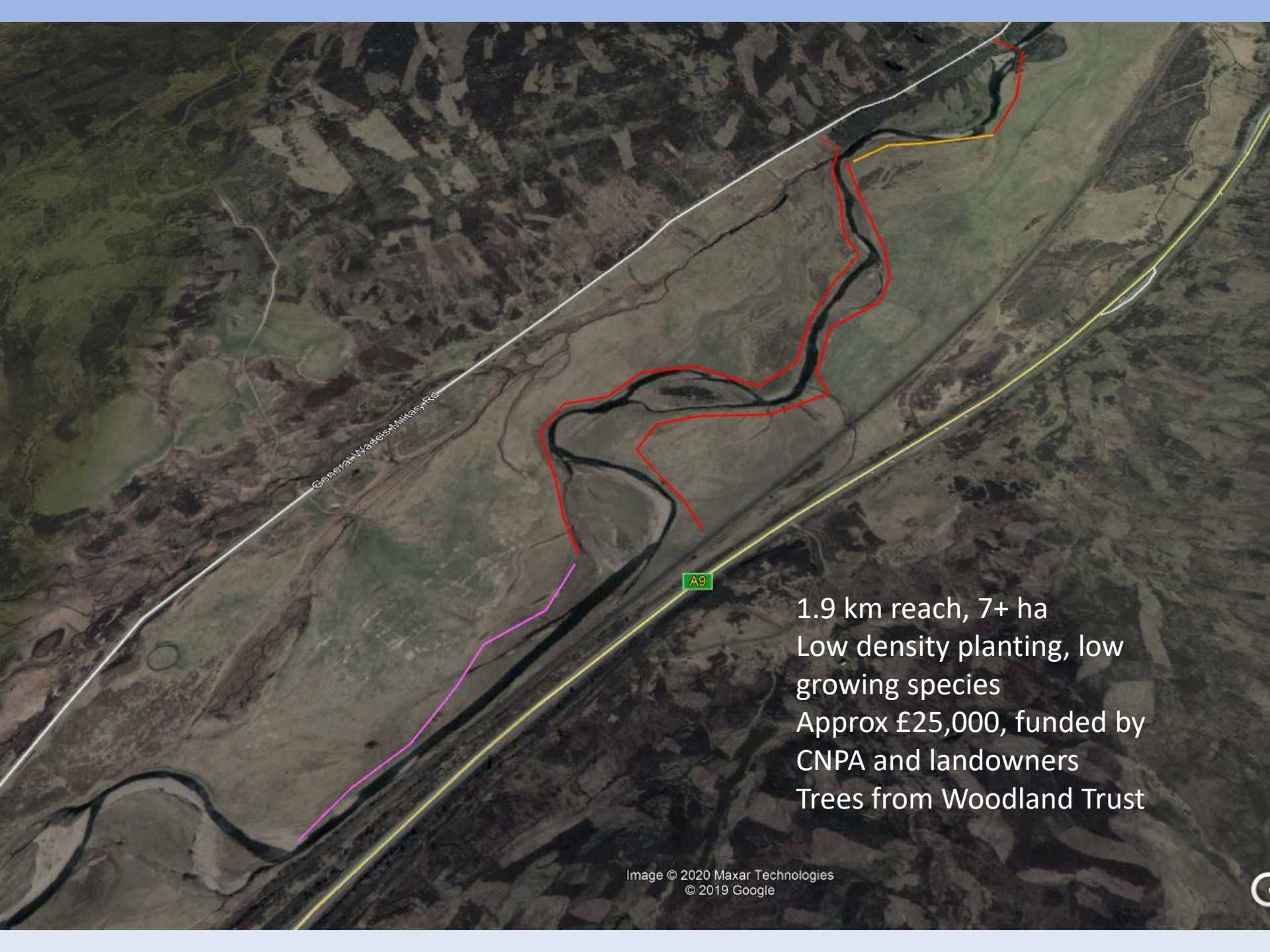
