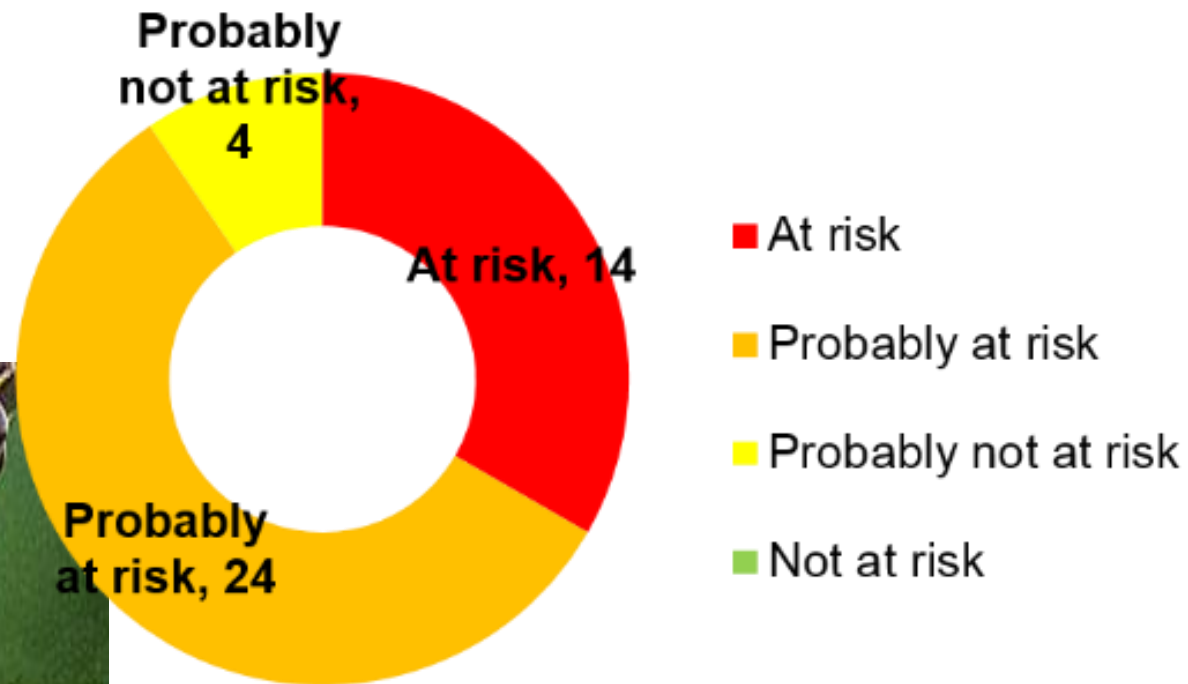
Global thinking – local action!

The Problem



- WWF's Living Planet Report shows that populations of **freshwater species** have **declined by 81% since 1970**, faster than in any other species group on the planet
- **14% of** rivers and lakes in England are at "good" status
- Water company - abstraction & discharges (over **50 serious pollution** incidents a year)
- Agriculture, soil erosion (**UK 2.2m tons pa**), diffuse pollution, pesticides, fertilisers & habitat loss
- Climate change
- Invasive Non Native Species (INNS)

38 of England's 42 principal salmon rivers are assessed as being 'At Risk', or 'Probably at Risk'. None categorised as 'Not at Risk'.
